This Week at the Chaplaincy:

1. Turin Shroud Exhibition at University Church at Nazareth House (9-21 Oct)

Next Sunday 9th October marks the official commencement of the Turin Shroud Exhibition. One of the purposes of the exhibition is to show how brutal crucifixion really was and to tell the story of the crucifixion of Jesus. The exhibition includes original Roman nails, a replica whip and a spear. And there are information boards about art, history and the latest research on the Shroud. No-one understands how the image appears on the Shroud. The STuRP team discovered it is not a painting; not a photograph and not a scorch but they could not determine the cause of the image. In December 2011 Italian scientists attempted to "identify the physical and chemical processes capable of generating a colour similar to that of the image on

the Shroud" by using short bursts of ultra violet light, using lasers.
